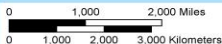

# Articles of the Week

## Articles 9, 10 and 11

### **These articles relate to staying in contact with your family:**

There are many different kinds of families and some children are not looked after by their birth families. The numbers of 'blended families' has increased. Every child has the right to be safe.

### **Article 9 (separation from parents)**

Children must not be separated from their parents against their will unless it is in their best interests (for example, if a parent is neglecting a child or unable to care for them safely). Children whose parents have separated have the right to stay in contact with both parents, unless this could cause them harm.





# Articles of the Week

## Articles 9, 10 and 11

### **Article 10 (family reunification)**

Governments must respond quickly and sympathetically if a child or their parents apply to live together in the same country. If a child's parents live apart in different countries, the child has the right to visit and keep in contact with both of them.

### **Article 11 (abduction and non-return of children)**

Governments must do everything they can to stop children being taken out of their own country illegally by their parents or other relatives, or being prevented from returning home.
