Forest School

Wednesday: Y5&6 (Group 1: 13 Sept - 11 Oct & Group 2: 1 Nov - 29 Nov)

Forest school club provides children with the opportunity to explore the great outdoors. We will head out to the Nature Trail in the school grounds after school. We offer a range of fun activities for the children such as playing in the mud kitchen, exploring nature, experimenting with outdoor art, constructing dens and some good old-fashioned outdoor fun! There is a £5 charge for this club as a hot chocolate and biscuit will also be offered each session. **The club will run for two 5-week periods so if your child is not successful in gaining a place at the start of term, they will be added to the waiting list for the second half of the term.**

Of course, health and safety is of paramount importance. We teach the children to use the tools and the environment safely. It is vital that children are properly dressed. **Children need to bring to school old clothes, a coat, welly boots and waterproof trousers to change into after school as we will still head out in the rain.** In winter, children should have lots of warm layers, hat and gloves. Research shows that art integration is crucial to creating well-rounded, well-prepared learners and leaders.

PROMOTES CREATIVITY, PROBLEM SOLVING AND INNOVATION
Creative crafting provides a platform for creative expression that nurtures imagination. Problem-solving, decision making and processing skills are all innate to a crafting activity.

ENCOURAGES SELF EXPRESSION
Creative crafting allows for the development of a sense of personal identity and teaches children to express themselves; giving parents and teachers insight into what a child is feeling, thinking and experiencing

BOOSTS SELF ESTEEM
Creative crafting activities create a sense of achievement in children and boosts their self-esteem. Teaching a child to create something tells them that they are in control. This builds immense confidence.

DEVELOPS FINE MOTOR SKILLS

Unlike academics and sports, creative crafting does not promote competition. On the contrary, it helps convert negative energy into positive habits.

Creative crafting not only incorporates STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Mathematics) elements, but also teaches valuable STEAM techniques, models and concepts that stimulate the imagination.

TEACHES FLEXIBILITY
Most craftwork can be achieved in more than one way. Unlike maths, where one doesn't have much flexibility, crafting teaches children that they can achieve the same result through a different method
