Musical Theatre – Spotlight Academy

Friday: Years 1 - 6, starting 24th April and finishing on 10th July 2026.

Musical Theatre Club will be continuing in the Spring term after school on Fridays for pupils in years 1 through to 6. The sessions will start on Friday 24th April 2026 and finish with an end of term presentation to parents on Friday 10th July from 4:30pm until 5pm.

Musical Theatre is a form of theatre combining music, songs, spoken dialogue and dance. These after school classes will be a fantastic opportunity to build confidence and learn new skills, with equal emphasis being given to acting, singing and dancing. The classes will be energetic and enjoyable sessions that will promote self-confidence in the children.

Block 1 for Year 3 & 4: Starting Thursday 23rd April until Thursday 21st May (5 weeks)

Block 2 for Year 5 & 6: Starting Thursday 4th June until Thursday 16th July (5 weeks)

This term, we will be offering two blocks for two different year groups, to give children in Year 5 & 6 the opportunity to take part once Booster sessions have concluded.

Across the term, there will be different activities available for the children to take part in. These will include but are not limited to:

- Elder jewellery
- Nature crowns
- Cooking on the fire
- Whittling
- Wish sticks
- Journey cards

Children taking part will need to bring wellies, a long sleeve top and long trousers even in warmer weather. These must be different to the clothes that they have worn to school during the day. Waterproofs are also advisable as children will get muddy.

Costs are £10 for 5 weeks, which contributes towards the materials required and the Forest School upkeep. Pick up is at 4.15 from Gate 4.
